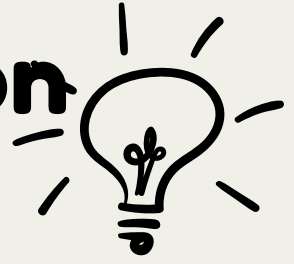

What is your opinion? What are you going to say!

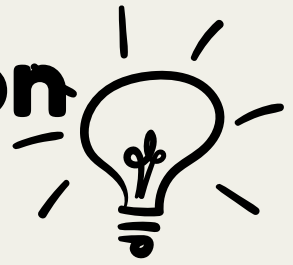
